


GIB has committed £18.2m into the UK's first renewable power plant powered by recovered wood and innovative gasification technology.

£1 from GIB mobilises **£1.60** private sector capital




Recovered wood

Recovered wood supplied by local small business JM Envirofuels Ltd





New 10.3 MWe recovered wood gasification facility in Tyseley, Birmingham
